THE SCHOOL

Robert Academy is a private, college-preparatory high school in the heart of Irvine, California, serving grades 9–12 on campus and online. Founded in 2024, the school operates as a California private school (affidavit on file with the California Department of Education) and offers a Cognia-accredited diploma. Year-round enrollment and self-paced or in-person study give each student a flexible path to graduation.

SIGNATURE PROGRAM: BUSINESS PATHWAY

Robert Academy is a business-themed high school where 100% of students hold at least a part-time position at a real company while completing their studies. Students graduate having managed real responsibilities, workplace relationships, and professional expectations — experience that shapes their coursework, college essays, and career direction. Admissions readers should view our students' employment not as an extracurricular, but as a core component of the academic program.

GRADING & RANK

Robert Academy uses a standard, unweighted 4.0 scale (A = 4.0, B = 3.0, C = 2.0, D = 1.0). No additional weight is given for AP or Honors coursework. The school does not rank students due to small class size and the rigor of the curriculum.

CURRICULUM

A rigorous college-preparatory program covering core subjects — mathematics, language arts, and science — plus electives aligned with each student's interests and career goals.

- 18 Advanced Placement courses — 100% of students complete at least one AP course.
- 30 Honors courses across the curriculum.
- Dual enrollment with the New Jersey Institute of Technology (NJIT) — students may earn up to 30 transferable college credits before graduation.
